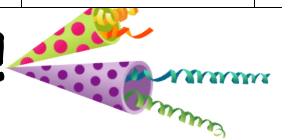

MEXICO MISSION TRIP

October 24th thru 30th Saltillo Mexico Trip

Please be in prayer as we prepare to go to Saltillo, Mexico again. The trip dates are Saturday- October 24th thru Friday the 30th for those who fly and Thursday October 22nd thru Saturday 31st for those who go on the van. We are trying to arrange for a van so make this a matter of prayer also. We need clothes for boys 4 years old, 21/2 and 1. We need clothes for a girl 7 years old. They can use something a year older as well. Good hand me downs will be fine. Any clothes for the ladies prisoners is also needed. We can also use any walkers, canes, etc. that you may have and don't need. We need vitamins and toothpaste but it is much cheaper to buy them at Sam's but any help with this cost would be a blessing. We will do medical this trip, but we are also scheduling so that we can spend more time ministering with the church members there. We hope to provide additional funds toward completing the church construction so that we can have a mission base for groups in the future, with real bathrooms and a kitchen. As always we are headed that way and we will do all that we can with what God provides. First Baptist Church Glencoe has already made a great impact on the lives of the the church there in Saltillo and the prisoners there as well. During the last 4 trips that we have had the pleasure of ministering with the Saltillo Church, we have seen over 400 people come to Christ, medically treated 727 people, fitted 350 people with glasses and taken the construction of the church from very little concrete flooring and walls with no roof, to having all the floors, almost all the walls complete and over half the roof completed. God willing we will be able to worship in this church soon with all the roof, pews, bathrooms and kitchen completed. God has taken us this far and I am trusting Him to allow us to complete what He has started. Thank you again for your prayers and support.
