

Dr. Greg Frizzell has had a great impact on the structure and content of my Daily Devotional Time. The following is one of three foundations that he presents for a powerful prayer life. "You must make an absolute commitment to consistently spend significant time alone with God in uninterrupted prayer." I try to implement this and the other foundations in my daily devotion time. It has worked well for me for about 15 years now.

The structure and content of my prayer time generally includes the following elements.

Daily I begin with Praise and Worship, continued by Confession and

Cleansing, then Petition for personal holiness and personal ministry. Meditation is also a great element for me; what is God saving to me in His word? Many times this is a part of Praise and worship, coming before **Confession and Petition. The only thing** that is usually always first is Praise and Worship which has several components of its own. Petition is the final component of my time and has content daily and for each day of the week. I keep all this in a notebook that helps to keep me on track. The Holy Spirit has freedom to adjust this time and content as He desires.

Whether at home, on vacation, or a mission trip far away, this daily time, early in the morning, is a priority for me. He is my Father. I love spending time with Him. Just today He assured me that His angels encamp about me. His Son, Jesus assured me that He is with me to the end of the age. The Holy Spirit assured me of His continued filling. What a blessing and joy to meet them the first thing every morning.
