- 8. Pray for His will to be done and for Him to be glorified as His loving intervention becomes clear.

- 4. Think of your friends.
- 5. Think of special teachers, mentors, pastors, youth leaders.
- 6. Think of memories you cherish.
- 7. Think of achievements God enabled in your life.
- 8. Think of spiritual milestones.
- 9. Think of special Scripture verses.
- 10. Think of times God has already delivered you.

- 1. Askyourself some questions.
- 2. Has Iesus become vour Savior? When?

- 6. What is the most remarkable gift He has given you since your salvation?
- 7. Who are some of His present-day disciples who have blessed you?
- 8. What is a recent discovery, accomplishment or friendship He has given you?
- 9. How many times has He forgiven you?

10. Where would you be now without Him?

Spend some time thanking God for all that Jesus means to you.
