Psalm 92: 1-5

It is good to give thanks to the LORD,
to sing praises to your name,
O Most High;
to declare your steadfast love in the morning
and your faithfulness
by night,
to the music of the lute and the harp,
to the melody of the lyre.
For you, O LORD, have made me glad
by your work;
at the works of your hands, I sing for joy.
How great are your works, O LORD!
Your thoughts are very deep!

NOVEMBER 1

All this is for our benefit, so that the grace that is reaching more and more people may cause thanksgiving to overflow to the glory of God.
(2 Corinthians 4:15)

NOVEMBER 2

Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good; his love endures forever. (1 Chronicles 16:34)

NOVEMBER 3

, . . . always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. (Ephesians 5:20)

NOVEMBER 4

Let us give thanks to the LORD for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for mankind, for he satisfies the thirsty and fills the hungry with good things.
(Psalm 107: 8-9)

NOVEMBER 5

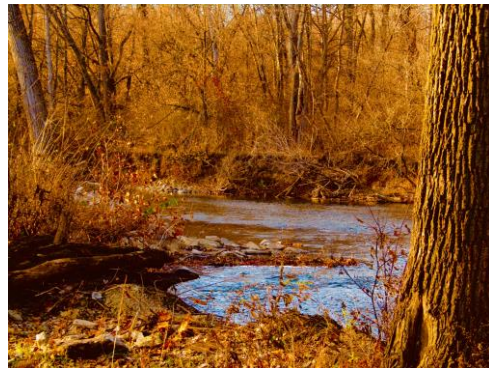
And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
(Colossians 3: 17)

NOVEMBER 6

Enters his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. (Psalm 100:4)

NOVEMBER 7

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
(Philippians 4: 6-7)



NOVEMBER 8

I will give thanks to you, LORD, with all my heart; I will tell of your wonderful deeds.
(Psalm 9:1)

NOVEMBER 9

I will give thanks to the LORD of his righteousness; I will sing the praises of the name of the LORD Most High. (Psalm 7:17)

NOVEMBER 10

The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and he helps me. My heart leaps for joy, and with my song I praise him.
(Psalm 28: 7)

NOVEMBER 11

Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. (Colossians 3: 16-17)

NOVEMBER 12

Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.

(Colossians 3:15)

NOVEMBER 13

Now, our God, we give thanks, and praise your glorious name.

(1 Chronicles 29:13)

NOVEMBER 14

Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful, and thankful. (Colossians 4:2)

NOVEMBER 15

Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name.

(Hebrews 13:15)

NOVEMBER 16

From them will come songs of thanksgiving and the sound of rejoicing. I will add to their numbers, and they will not be decreased; I will bring them honor, and they will not be disdained. (JEREMIAH 30:19)



NOVEMBER 17

“Sacrifice thank offers to God, fulfill your vows to the Most High. (Psalm 50:14)

NOVEMBER 18

I will praise God’s name in song and glorify him with thanksgiving. (Psalm 69:30)

NOVEMBER 19

Because of the LORD’s great love, we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail.

They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness. (Lamentations 3:22-23)

NOVEMBER 20

I always thank my God for you because of his grace given you in Christ Jesus. For in him you have been enriched in every way—with all kinds of speech and with all knowledge— (1 Corinthians 1: 4-5)

NOVEMBER 21

Praise the LORD. Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever.

(Psalm 106:1)

NOVEMBER 22

And now we thank you, our God, and praise your glorious name. (1 Chronicles 29:13)

NOVEMBER 23

But I, with shouts of grateful praise, will sacrifice to you. What I have bowed I will make good. I will say, “Salvation comes from the Lord.” (Jonah 2: 9)

NOVEMBER 24

In God, whose word I praise—in God I trust and am not afraid. What can mere mortals do? (Psalm 56:4)

NOVEMBER 25

You have enlarged the nation and increased their joy; they rejoice before you as people rejoice at the harvest, as soldiers rejoice when dividing the plunder. (Isaiah 9:3)

NOVEMBER 26

I will sing of the Lord’s great love forever; with my mouth I will make your faithfulness known through all generations. I will declare that your love stands firm forever, that you have stablished your faithfulness in Heaven itself.

(Psalm 89: 1-2)

NOVEMBER 27

It is good to praise the Lord and make music to your name, O Most High, proclaiming your love in the morning and your faithfulness at night, to the music of the ten-stringed lyre and the melody of the harp. (Psalm 92: 1-3)

The earth has yielded its produce; God, our God, blesses us. (Psalm 67:6)
