- 1. If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land. (2 Chronicles 7:14)
- 2. God did this so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him, though he is not far from any one of us. (Acts 17:27)
- 3. And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him. (Hebrews 11:6)
- 4. Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify

your hearts, you double-



minded. (James 4: 8)

- 5. Look to the LORD and his strength; seek his face always. (1 Chronicles 16:11)
- 6. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. (Matthew 6:33)
- 7. I love those who love me, and those who seek me find me. (Proverbs 8: 17)
- 8. Those who know your name trust in you, for you, LORD, have never forsaken those who seek you. (Psalm 9: 10)
- 9. The LORD looks down from heaven on all mankind to see if there are any who understand, any who seek God. (Psalm 14: 2)
- The lions may grow weak and hungry, but those who seek the LORD lack no good thing. (Psalm 34: 10)
- 11. But may all who seek you rejoice and be glad in you; may those who long for your saving help always say, "The LORD is great!"

12. Look to the LORD and his strength; seek his presence continually. (Psalm 105: 4)
